



PARALLEL CURVES AND SPIRALS

Dealing with measurements, proportions, and finger placement is the mechanics of good drawing. However, it is equally important to understand the hand as a larger, interrelated system of *natural rhythms*. When fingers are extended to their limit, as shown in the upper drawing, two of these natural rhythms occur. The extended fingers show subtle crests and troughs, and an upswing develops at the fingertips, which seem enormously energized. A second rhythm sweeps in arcs from knuckle to knuckle and from palm to fingertips. The drawing at bottom shows the almost riblike curves of the fingers. When they swing parallel across the hand, starting at the palm and continuing to the fingertips, the general design of the hand can be quickly envisioned.
