The canonical account of protocol equivalence in PLEN turns out to possess a number of interesting formal features including satisfaction of important conditions on hyperintensional equivalence a matter of recently recognized importance in the logic of norms generally To show that the system is interesting and useful as a framework for representing and reasoning about epistemic norms the author applies the logical system to the analysis of epistemic deontic operators and partly on the basis of this establishes representation theorems linking protocols to the action guiding content of epistemic norms.
